INTRODUCTION

Beloved, the desire of our Lord Jesus Christ is for us to seek Him while He may be found, and in His presence, to grow in love. I thank God for 2025, a year in which our ministry and family experienced His abundant mercies.

I have declared the year 2026 as "THE YEAR OF A NEW BEGINNING OR SALVATION." This declaration comes from the understanding that when you add 2 + 6, the result is 8. In prophetic numerology, the number 8 signifies "**NEW BEGINNINGS AND SALVATION.**" It represents a new order or a new creation.

As stated in **2 Corinthians 5:17**: Therefore if anyone is in Christ, this person is a **NEW CREATION**; the old things passed away; behold, **NEW THINGS** have come.

January 4

BIBLE VERSE: Genesis 7:21-24

TOPIC: SAVED BY OBEDIENCE

Genesis 7:21-24

21 So all creatures that moved on the earth perished: birds, livestock, animals, and every swarming thing that swarms upon the earth, and all mankind; 22 of all that was on the dry land, all in whose nostrils was the breath of the spirit of life, died. 23 So He wiped out every living thing that was upon the face of the land, from mankind to animals, to crawling things, and the birds of the sky, and they were wiped out from the earth; and only Noah was left, together with those that were with him in the ark. 24 The water prevailed upon the earth for 150 days.

1 Peter 3:20

who once were disobedient when the patience of God kept waiting in the days of Noah, during the construction of the ark, in which a few, that is, eight persons, were brought safely through the water.

We cannot begin a new chapter in life without the willingness to die to earthly ways. The year 2026 presents a new opportunity for us to be determined to seek our salvation and enter the Kingdom.

January 5

BIBLE VERSE: Genesis 17:12

TOPIC: A DIRTY HEART HAS NO RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

Genesis 17:12-14

12 And every male among you who is eight days old shall be circumcised throughout your generations, including a slave who is born in the house or who is bought with money from any foreigner, who is not of your descendants. 13 A slave who is born in your house or who is bought with your money shall certainly be circumcised; so My covenant shall be in your flesh as an everlasting covenant. 14 But as for an uncircumcised male, one who is not circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin, that person shall be cut off from his people; he has broken My covenant.”

This covenant with Abraham represented a new relationship with God. God established this covenant with Abraham because of his faith and obedience, and it had an outward sign: circumcision.

Circumcision symbolizes the purification of our hearts. Today, we are not physically removing a foreskin; rather, God expects us to willingly eliminate everything that displeases Him.

PROPHETIC ACT: Through an act of faith and obedience, let us demonstrate a willingness to turn away from all impure practices and manifest a change in our lives, recognizing our need for transformation. A new beginning consists of living a holy life dedicated to the mediator of the covenant.

January 6

BIBLE VERSE: John 20:26

TOPIC: DON'T LET DOUBT CLOSE THE DOOR OF YOUR HEART

John 20:26

Eight days later His disciples were again inside, and Thomas was with them. Jesus came, the doors having been shut, and stood in their midst and said, "Peace be to you."

Thomas, one of Jesus' disciples, was filled with fear, a sense of failure, and unbelief. His leader, in whom he had placed his trust and hope, had been crucified. Even though his friends had shared the good news with him, doubt had entered his heart.

We all face challenging situations in life that can leave us feeling like Thomas, lacking faith and shutting the door of our hearts, giving up on everything.

Leaving a cell group or a church is one of the saddest things you can do. When we gather together, that's when the visitation of Jesus occurs, bringing us peace.

PROPHETIC ACT: Open your heart. Renounce the fear of failure and disbelief that may have been caused by a leader. Affirm your faith and commit to being a disciple of Christ. Let your transformed life be a testament so that others may believe in Jesus.

January 7

BIBLE VERSE: 2 Chronicles 34:1-3

TOPIC: LET'S BE GENUINE AND RADICAL

2 Chronicles 34:1-2

1 Josiah was eight years old when he became king, and he reigned for thirty-one years in Jerusalem. 2 He did what was right in the sight of the Lord, and walked in the ways of his father David and did not turn aside to the right or the left.

When we come to know Jesus through revelation, we realize that the Lord desires for us to establish His kingdom and reign with Him as kings. However, not everyone has a kingdom mindset, as adopting this mindset often leads us to face challenges that set us apart from others.

Josiah faced the challenge of reigning by doing what was right in God's eyes, following the path of his spiritual father, David. He did not waver or show double-mindedness. Throughout his reign, he eliminated idolatry, repaired the temple, discovered the Book of the Law, and restored true worship to God.

The Lord saved you so that through your life, you can cleanse and uproot sin, first in yourself and in your home—such as idols, worldly music, hidden sins, etc.—so that others may witness your transformation.

PROPHETIC ACT: Search your heart, examine and evaluate yourself. Do you truly want a new beginning in your spiritual life? Cast aside double-mindedness and reflect on who occupies the place that belongs to the Lord. Restore your temple, care for your soul and body, serve Him with all your heart, and begin a journey of learning about the Word of God. Strengthen your faith in Christ Jesus!

January 8

BIBLE VERSE: Isaiah 43:19

TOPIC: GOD WILL MAKE A WAY WHERE THERE IS NO WAY

Isaiah 43:19

Behold, I am going to do SOMETHING NEW,
Now it will spring up;
Will you not be aware of it?
I will even make a roadway in the wilderness,
Rivers in the desert.

We often feel excitement when we encounter new things, whether it's a new car, a new house, new friends, or a new job. New beginnings bring emotions that can be exhilarating and unique, making us think they may never happen again. However, we tend to overlook the fact that every new beginning is preceded by the end or culmination of something that may not have been pleasant. This could involve the loss of a material possession, the end of a romantic relationship, or letting go of something we know is not right in God's eyes. All of these experiences lead us to make decisions that will shape our future.

We can choose to rise above the pain, frustration, and suffering, using every adverse situation as a closing chapter of the past. By allowing the Holy Spirit and God's blessed Word to propel us into a "New Beginning," we can embrace the fresh opportunities He has prepared for us. Alternatively, we can choose to remain stagnant, trapped in the same unproductive cycle of living.

Sometimes, we lack the prophetic vision to see what God has in store for our lives. As a result, we might prefer to stay in our current condition. However, it is essential to remember that God always desires to do something new in each of us.

PROPHETIC ACT: Take some time to be in the Lord's presence and meditate on the verses presented. Reflect on your faith in the one God who can create something new in an instant. Declare it in prayer, and you will witness it. God will make a way where there is no way.

January 9th

BIBLE VERSE: Acts 9:32

TOPIC: IT'S TIME TO RISE UP

Acts 9:32-35

32 Now as Peter was traveling through all those regions, he also came down to the saints who lived at Lydda. 33 There he found a man named Aeneas who had been bedridden for eight years, because he was paralyzed. 34 Peter said to him, "Aeneas, Jesus Christ heals you; get up and make your own bed." Immediately he got up. 35 And all who lived at Lydda and Sharon saw him, and they turned to the Lord.

When we are committed to the Kingdom and the vision, and we have been given authority and power, we need to put it into practice.

Peter was visiting the believers when he encountered someone who was paralyzed. A paralytic is someone who has lost the ability to move their legs. Paralysis can be permanent or partial and can affect any part of the body, often accompanied by a loss of sensation.

Spiritual paralysis occurs when a person loses the ability to progress in their spiritual life. This form of paralysis can affect the mind, heart, or soul and can be caused by factors such as sin, workaholicism, unforgiveness, or spiritual immaturity.

Aeneas had been in that condition for eight years when the Lord's command came.

1. JESUS CHRIST HEALS YOU

2. GET UP

3. AND MAKE YOUR BED. This means enough is enough! MOVE, ORDER YOUR LIFE, because those eight years of being bedridden are over. It is time to manifest the miracle of Christ in your life; you are important in the Kingdom of Jesus Christ.

PROPHETIC ACT: Remain in the presence of the Lord and examine your heart. Ask yourself, "How many years have I been spiritually paralyzed?" Change your thoughts to align with God's thoughts! Your victory or failure lies in your own mind.

Since when have you lost your sensitivity? Examine which part of your life is paralyzed and rise up to do the will of the One who sustains your life.

If you need to forgive someone, forgive them. If you need to forgive yourself, forgive yourself. Only forgiveness and an attitude of recognition can HEAL and LIBERATE.

January 10th

BIBLE VERSE: 1 Samuel 17:12-14

TOPIC: TAKING CARE OF OTHER PEOPLE'S SHEEP LEADS YOU TO THE PALACE

1 Samuel 17:12

12 Now David was the son of the Ephrathite of Bethlehem in Judah, the man whose name was Jesse, and he had eight sons. And Jesse was old in the days of Saul, advanced in years among men.

1 Samuel 16:10-11

10 So Jesse had seven of his sons pass before Samuel. But Samuel said to Jesse, "The Lord has not chosen these." 11 Then Samuel said to Jesse, "Are these all the boys?" And he said, "The youngest is still left, but behold, he is tending the sheep." So Samuel said to Jesse, "Send word and bring him; for we will not take our places at the table until he comes here."

I want to urge and encourage you, no matter if you are the first, second, or EIGHTH child, or the "ugly duckling" of the family—whether by birth or spiritual birth. In God, we already have a POSITION in the kingdom. David was tending his father's sheep and running errands for his brothers while they were very close to the KING and in the king's army.

1. He was tending the sheep when the prophet sent by God arrived to anoint him. David was the EIGHTH SON, perhaps doing what the others didn't want to do or didn't recognize his potential for. By fulfilling this assignment, he developed God-given skills to defend what didn't belong to him.

2. He learned to know God more deeply; he was a worshipper who showed his devotion through service, caring for the sheep. He rescued them from wild animals, watched over them, sacrificed himself, and fought to save them.

3. When you take care of what belongs to others, they will give you what is yours. They will empower you to defeat your giant.

4. When you take care of what has been entrusted to you, your promotion day will come.

5. They will send for you when God knows you are doing what you have been entrusted with.

6. When you do your service for the King, He will reward you.

PROPHETIC ACT: Develop a correct identity and examine yourself to see if you have been faithful in what God entrusted to you this year, 2025. Sometimes, we don't need someone to judge us on whether we did something right or wrong, willingly or reluctantly. In this new beginning, strive to become a David for the kingdom of God. Decide to lead the flock.

January 11th

BIBLE VERSE: Acts 2:1-4

TOPIC: FILLING OF THE BEAUTIFUL HOLY SPIRIT

Acts 2:1-4

1 When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. 2 And suddenly a noise like a violent rushing wind came from heaven, and it filled the whole house where they were sitting. 3 And tongues that looked like fire appeared to them, distributing themselves, and a tongue rested on each one of them. 4 And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with different tongues, as the Spirit was giving them the ability to speak out.

1. The day of Pentecost was the feast of first fruits.
2. Those who converted to Christianity on that day were considered the first fruits of a powerful harvest of souls.
3. It marked the beginning, a powerful start for the disciples, to establish the Kingdom. Although Jesus had ascended to the Father, He promised to send one like Himself to fill us with His power.
4. The Church is an instrument of the Kingdom; it is not a passive entity. It must be filled with the power of the Holy Spirit so that the disciples may flow in the fire of God.
5. To achieve this, we, as members of the Church, must have the right ATTITUDE, the right HUMILITY, and be TOGETHER IN HARMONY.
6. **UNANIMOUSLY TOGETHER: HOMOTHUMADON** (Strong #3661)
This means being in agreement, maintaining unity within the group, sharing a single purpose, and being of one mind.
7. The disciples exhibited intellectual unity, emotional harmony, and a shared will within the Church.
8. They were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them. The Holy Spirit transforms the way we speak; murmuring, complaining, and bad language grieve the Holy Spirit.
9. If we desire the power of the Holy Spirit to flow in our lives, to ENTER A NEW SEASON OF SPIRITUAL VITALITY and be instruments who take others to SALVATION, we must recognize and invite THE PERSON OF THE HOLY SPIRIT to minister to us. Do not grieve Him; don't leave Him at the door—let Him into your innermost being. He knows what you see, say, do, and hear.
10. Seek unity within your family, and in the Church, ask for forgiveness from those you know you need to forgive. Forgiveness is essential for peace.

PROPHETIC ACT: Let us cultivate unity, harmony, and forgiveness so that nothing causes division, allowing the HOLY SPIRIT with His FIRE, to burn away anything that hinders God's purpose.
