# **Protocols for Attendees**

#### Stay home if...

- O If you are ill or feel mildly ill.
- o If you specifically have any of these signs or symptoms: cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache (of any kind), sore throat, loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, feel feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit, or known close contact with a person who is lab confirmed to have COVID-19.
- Nursery and Children's Ministry is temporarily closed.

# Saturday - (or the day before scheduled church service)

- Remind your family that doors will open Sunday at 9:30 a.m. and will close at 10:05 a.m. No late entry allowed.
- Use the south entrance doors for entry/exit.
- Available restrooms are located south of the main auditorium.
- We ask that you do not venture into spaces of the building other than the auditorium and designated restrooms.
- Children must stay with parents at all times.

## Sunday - At Home (or the day of scheduled church service)

- 1. Grab your cloth face covering (over the nose and mouth). Attendees with no cloth face covering or face mask will be sent home.
- 2. Grab your Bible, notepad, and pen.
- 3. Bring anything else you may need, such as small bottle water, pocket size hand sanitizer, and tissue. Come prepared so that you avoid touching any regularly touched surfaces.

#### **Sunday - Driving to Church**

- 1. Remind your family to stay together at all times as a family unit and stay within your assigned seating area inside auditorium.
- 2. Maintain at least 6 feet separation from other individuals or family units.
- 3. Members of the same household may sit together.
- 4. Wear your face covering (over mouth and nose) at all times; practice hand hygiene, cough etiquette, cleanliness, and sanitation.


#### **Sunday - Parking**

- Put on your face covering (over mouth and nose) or face mask.
   Carry an extra one, sometimes they break.
- 2. Face coverings are required for children. Note: Cloth face coverings should NOT be put on babies and children under age two because of the danger of suffocation.
- 3. Gloves are not required. Only ushers will have gloves on.
- 4. Bring your Bible, notepad, and pen.
- 5. Stay and walk together as a family unit. Spouses hold hands. Parents should hold their children's hand.

#### **Sunday - Church Entry**

- 1. Follow the markers on the floor.
- 2. Attendees will be screened before coming into church temperature screening.
- 3. All attendees will sanitize their hands and put on a mask before entering the building.
- 4. Stay on the right side of hallways.

- 1. Stay inside the green all other areas are off limits.
- 2. Do not walk in between empty sections of chairs.
- Only walk parallel or perpendicular to the platform. Follow the arrows to and from your seat.



#### **Sunday - During Church Service**

- During entry, tithing/offering envelopes will be available for pickup on a table. A self-service collection receptacle will be available on your way out on same table. Thank you for sowing in the Kingdom of God.
- 2. Stay in your seat area with your family unit. Refrain from standing up and walking around the auditorium.
- 3. Children must stay with parents at all times.
- 4. Keep your face covering or face mask on at all times.
- 5. Follow the same floor markings to the restroom, if needed.

#### **Sunday - Dismissal**

- 1. Please stay seated.
- 2. When live-transmission has ended, wait for instructions to be dismissed by family unit to maintain social distancing.
- 3. Make sure to take all your belongings and follow the same path toward your vehicle.
- 4. Keep walking until you reach your vehicle. Please do not stop to socialize.


